The Steve Miller Band

w/ special guest Marty Stuart & His Fabulous Superlatives

Sunday, July 28, 6:30pm at UPAC in Kingston, Doors 5:30pm

The Steve Miller Band was a mainstay of the San Francisco music scene that upended American culture in the late '60s. Miller perfected a psychedelic blues sound that drew on the deepest sources of American roots music and simultaneously articulated a compelling vision of what music - and, indeed, society - could be in the years to come. Then, in the '70s, Miller crafted a brand of pure pop that was polished, exciting and irresistible - and that dominated radio in a way that few artists have ever managed. One of rock music's all-time greats and a 2016 inductee into the Rock n' Roll Hall of Fame, The Steve Miller Band has sold more than 30 million records in a career spanning more than 50 years. His trademark blues-rock sound made him one of the key artists in classic rock radio. Miller's list of hits from the late 60s to the early 80s is vast and includes: *Space Cowboy*, *My Dark Hour*, *The Joker*, *Fly Like an Eagle*, *Take the Money and Run*, *Rock'n Me*, *Jet Airliner*, *Jungle Love*, *Swingtown* and *Apracadabra*.

Grammy winning country star **Marty Stuart and His Fabulous Superlatives** will open the show. Stuart began his career on the road with Lester Flatt when he was 13 years and then became part of Johnny Cash's band before breaking out on his own. Stuart's country hits include *Arlene*, *Tempted*, *Little Things*, and *Burn Me Down*. His duets with Travis Tritt, *The Whiskey Ain't Workin* and *This One's Gonna Hurt You For A Long Long Time*, also became country hits.
