City and Colour (singer, songwriter Dallas Green) has resonated throughout the international independent music scene. Following the 2005 debut *Sometimes*, and the Double-Platinum certified *Bring Me Your Love* (2008) Green debuted at #1 in Canada on three consecutive releases — the Double-Platinum *Little Hell* (2011), the Platinum *The Hurry and the Harm* (2013), and Gold-certified *If I Should Go Before You* (2015) which also debuted at #16 on the U.S. Billboard 200 Chart and #5 in Australia where Green's LP *Little Hell* was certified Gold. City and Colour will perform a rare solo show.
